

2026-2027 PE & SPORT SERVICE FOR SHREWSBURY AREA PRIMARY SCHOOLS

The following service packages continue to be designed following consultation with partner schools across the Shrewsbury area. Our system works on a 3-tiered basis with a list of additional services if required.

All packages include a 25% discount on entrance to TSA Events (already included in package costings)

THREE - TIERED SERVICE OPTIONS 2026-2027

Gold Package £2,400: will have positive impact across the whole school and ensure your PE and Sport needs for the year are taken care of:

1. Unlimited additional events across the year
2. Access to centralised staff CPD opportunities
3. Centralised leadership academy = ½ day delivery x3 – More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events / activities – 1 per term
4. 1 intra school competition of your schools choosing in the calendar year (delivered on school site includes ½ day delivery training of young leaders and then organising and running an event)
5. Active starter morning = ½ day delivery – young leaders support to lead active breaktime / lunchtimes (can be delivered in conjunction with lunchtime supervisors training / mentoring programme)
6. 10% discount on Getset4pe subscription
7. 5% discount on transport on all events

GOLD

Silver Package, £1,836 will have positive impact in your school and provide added value to your PE and Sport Provision

1. 16 TSA events across the year (School free to select individual events)
2. Access to centralised staff CPD opportunities
3. Centralised leadership academy = ½ day delivery x3 – More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events / activities – 1 per term
4. 1 intra school competition of your schools choosing in the calendar year (delivered on school site includes ½ day delivery training of young leaders and then organising and running an event)

SILVER

Bronze package, £1,225: will support your school's basic PE and Sport Provision

BRONZE

1. 10 TSA events across the year (school free to select their individual events)
2. Access to Primary Summer Inset morning
3. Centralised leadership academy = ½ day delivery x3 – More in-depth training of young leaders in key leadership skills, organising and running events/activities – 1 per term.

ADD ON MENU

In addition to your chosen package, you may also wish to choose an unlimited number of add on programmes from the menu below. Please note it is only possible to purchase add-on services if you are purchasing one of the packages listed above.

- 1 day teaching across year - £8,000
- ½ day teaching across year - £4,000
- ½ day teaching across term - £1,350
- In school CPD open to all staff 1 per ½ term = £1,000 or 1 per term =£515, each £200
- Curriculum planning and support (one initial meeting, 2 days creation of resources/ implementation) £450
- After school club all year - £1,250*
- After school club – per ½ term = £215 / 1 term =£430*
- Intra school Competitions = ½ day delivery x6 – training leaders, organising and running event – 1 per half term - £920 or 1 per term = £465
- Additional competition places x5 events = £500 x 10 events = £1000
- Day themed event delivery – e.g. sports day/Olympic day/This Girl/Boy can £250
- Leadership Academy training – for a small cohort of Y5/6 leaders x 3 sessions p/yr - £465
- Playground leaders training (can be delivered in conjunction with lunchtime supervisors training/mentoring programme) – x ½ day delivery of training including resources for trained leaders/lunchtime supervisors - £300
- Well Schools – initial exploration meeting, Well Schools Check meeting, end of year evaluation, accreditation review and next steps meeting (3x ½ days p/yr) - £450
- Active in Mind – delivery of Active in Mind training to selected staff mentor in school. Delivery of a 6-week AIM module with a school cohort of vulnerable pupils (preferably working alongside trained staff) – £900
- Active teaching across the curriculum – ideas and resources for creating a truly active school, e.g. active classrooms/curriculum - £150
- Active play – training for lunchtime staff (preferably in conjunction with playground leaders in relation to meaningful active play activities during breaks/lunchtimes (delivery of a 6-week block of work with staff/leaders) - £600

The Service Provider will provide written notice of any proposed variation to Charges, including details of the cost increase, prior to the variation taking effect.

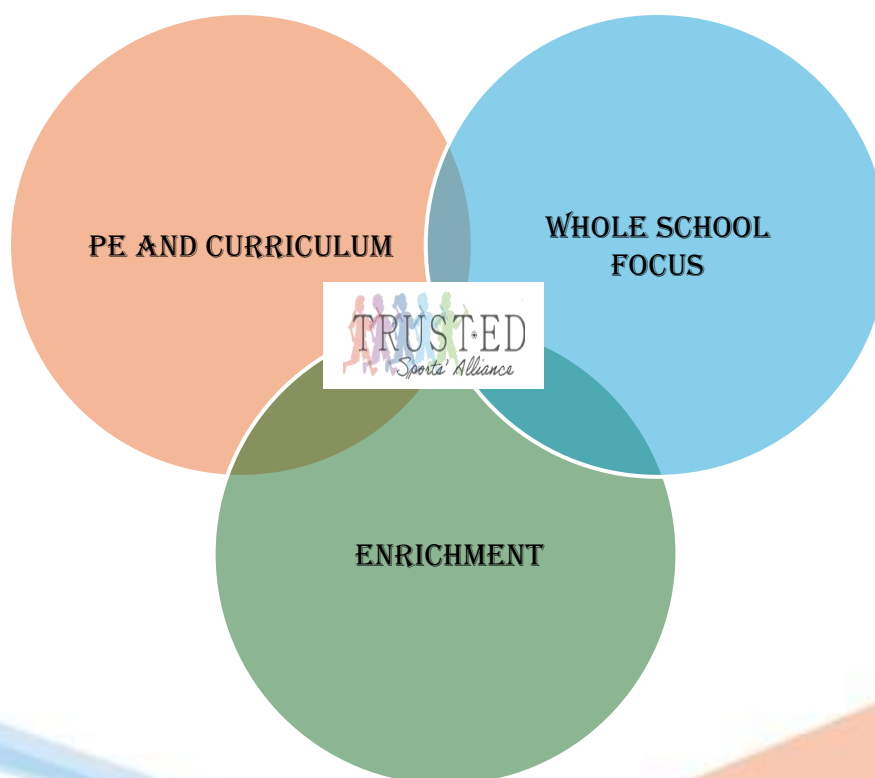
Delivery of the Service is subject to sufficient demand

PE AND CURRICULUM

- **Delivery of high quality and experienced PE/team teaching from EYFS – KS2:**
Full or ½ day team teaching across the year, or on a ½ termly /termly basis.
- **CPD for whole staff - 3 per year**
Content to be decided by school to promote strength in all areas of PE
- **Curriculum mapping, assessment and planning support**
One meeting p/term, 2 days creation of resources/implementation. E.g. creating OAA/Dance programme in line with the new curriculum and assessment review for PE
- **Delivery of TSA wide CPD programme**
Annual seminar/ spring PE leads focus meeting / School Games Mark application
- **Signposting to national/local CPD opportunities**
Access to National Governing Body – resources and training/ local club links promotional events
- **Access to Get Set 4 PE platform**
Up to 10% discount on Getset4PE Subscription to all TSA member schools. Available to schools with silver and gold packages.

WHOLE SCHOOL FOCUS

- **Well schools – support to access whole school improvement programme focussing on pupil and staff wellbeing**
Initial exploration meeting, Well Schools Check meeting, end of year evaluation, accreditation review and next steps meeting (3x ½ days p/yr)
- **Active in mind**
Active in Mind – delivery of Active in Mind training to selected staff mentor in school. Delivery of a 6-week AIM module with a school cohort of vulnerable pupils
- **Active teaching across the curriculum**
Active teaching across the curriculum – ideas and resources for creating a truly active school, e.g. active classrooms/curriculum
- **Active play and supervisor training and support**
Training for lunchtime staff (preferably in conjunction with playground leaders in relation to meaningful active play activities during breaks/lunchtimes (6-week block of work with staff/leaders)

Playground leaders training (can be delivered in conjunction with lunchtime supervisors training/mentoring programme) – x ½ day delivery of training including resources for trained leaders/lunchtime supervisors
- **Transition events at local secondary schools**
Events – access to events as part of TSA area event programmes (mix of inspire, engage and compete events to support transition, targeted, mass participation and pathway across academic year)*
- **Cluster events at local primary schools**
Inspire and engage events for small cluster groups – bespoke to the areas needs
- **In school Intra house events programme**
Intra-School events – 1 intra-school competition delivered on school site per half-term or term - including the training of sports leaders from host school or provision of sports leaders from local secondary school to support
- **Whole class/ school festivals**
Themed event delivery – ‘World Cup’, ‘Olympics’, ‘Commonwealth Games’, ‘This Girl Can’, ‘This Boy Can’ – you choose theme and as many as you would like across the year
- **After school provision**
Delivery of an after-school sports related club – 1 club p/week across a half-term(s), term or across the academic year*
